The Earth is made mostly of rock. It has both liquid and frozen water on its surface. Earth is surrounded by an atmosphere of gases. The Earth rotates, or spins, once every 24 hours.

The Moon is also made of rock. It does not have liquid water or an atmosphere. The Moon is a satellite of Earth. It orbits, or goes around, the Earth once about every 27 days.

The Moon rotates once every time it orbits around the Earth. This means that from Earth we only ever see one side of the Moon.

The Earth and Moon system orbits around the Sun.

The Sun is a star. It is made of hot, glowing gases and plasma. It is at the center of our solar system. All of the planets orbit around it.
